**Fees:**

1- For direct one on one settlement discussions with the examiner with NO Mediator present, \$50 per party.

2- For those cases that do not settle after one on one settlement discussions, the parties may agree to mediate the case with a NAM mediator. In these instances, each party will receive a \$50 credit against their standard NAM mediation fees.

3- For mediations that are set up and scheduled in advance to be mediated with a NAM Mediator (and not scheduled for direct one on one settlement discussions), the plaintiff firm will receive a 20% discount from their NAM mediation administrative fee.
